



Dear Parent/Carer(s),

I have great pleasure in welcoming you and your child to Hyde High School and I would like to invite you and your child to our **'Moving Up'** information evening on **Thursday 26th May 2022**. This is the first stage in your child's transition to secondary school. The event will run from 5pm to 7pm and you are welcome to call in at any time during this session – we would recommend that you allow at least 45 minutes for your visit.

The evening will be an opportunity to meet key staff who will play a role in your child's successful transition from primary to secondary school. There will be a 20 minute presentation in the Activities Suite at 5.30pm to outline our expectations and to explain how we will support your child's move to Hyde High School; this will be repeated at 6.30pm. You will also have the chance to visit our Marketplace where you can ask any questions and collect further resources including information about school uniform, behaviour and attendance, curriculum, special educational needs and pastoral support.

There will be an opportunity to hear from current Year 7 students about their own experiences of moving up to Hyde. We will be launching our team-building weekend at PGL, Boreatton Park. This is an event especially for Year 7 and is heavily subsidised by the school to enable as many students as possible to take part and to benefit from getting to know classmates and staff in a different setting. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis. Should you wish to do so, you will be able to reserve your child's place with a deposit via the school's Parentpay system.

Your child's transition to Hyde will involve two taster days on Thursday 7th July and Friday 8th July 2022.

So that you can make the most of this evening, we would politely ask that you please leave other children at home.
