RE: Sex and health education (PHSE)

As part of the school's Personal, Health and Social Education recovery curriculum, your child will receive a series of lessons on sexual health and personal safety. These lessons will be delivered by a government agency called 'you think' and will be take place this term.

The aim of the PHSE curriculum is to provide knowledge and understanding of safe and healthy living relationships based on love and respect. This is to encourage the eventual development of safe and healthy relationships in later life. The curriculum will develop understanding and attitudes which will help students to form relationships in a responsible and healthy manner and to appreciate the value of family life.

I should also bring to your attention that as part of our e-safety programme students will also be made aware of online exploitation and the procedures to follow should a student feel threatened in any way.
