## Skirts that are acceptable for school



Guidance relating to skirts:

- Skirts must be plain black and sit smartly on the waist;
- Length must be no more than 10cm above the knee (measured when kneeling);
- Length must be no more than 10cm below the knee (from centre of kneecap);
- Denim, cord, canvas and Lycra garments are not acceptable;
- The style must be appropriate for a range of school activities i.e. not excessively tight or fitted;
- Skirts must be worn in a way that does not reveal underwear;
- Mini skirts or skirts with a high slit are not allowed.

Please note: we understand that different students have different body shapes and sizes; if you are unable to obtain a skirt which meets our guidelines, then trousers should be worn.
