Arrival	What to do
I have a morning exam	Go to registration as normal at 8:35am
I have a lesson Period 1	Go to registration as normal at 8:35am
I do not have an exam or a lesson Period 1, I am coming in for a lesson later in the day.	Arrive in school no more than 5 minutes before the start of your lesson. Sign in on the sheets in the dining area and go straight to your lesson.
I have no exam or lessons in the morning, I am coming in for an afternoon exam.	Arrive in school 10 minutes before your exam start time. Sign in on the sheets in the dining area and go straight to your exam venue.

Leaving before the end of the school day.	What to do
I have finished my morning exam and am going home.	Sign out immediately on the sheets in the dining area and make your way home.
I have finished my lesson and am going home.	Sign out immediately on the sheets in the dining area and make your way home.

There may be a situation where you have an exam until 10:30 and then a lesson at 11:15am and a gap in between. If this is the case and you wish to stay in school to study, **you must go straight away to your timetabled classroom**. You cannot work in open learning areas or anywhere else in school. Anyone wandering or not in their allocated classroom will be asked to leave.

Once exams are over we will hold a final **Leavers' Assembly** for the Class of 2023 where you will be able to celebrate being together as a year group one last time, sign shirts, take photos and we will take a little walk down memory lane looking at your 5 years at Hyde.
